- 4. A bottle holds 3 cups of juice Sita drink 1 cup of juice. How much juice is left in the bottle?
- 5. A bucket holds 14 mugs of water. Ravi used 4 mugs of water. How much water is left in the bucket?
- 6. A bowl holds 2 cups of soup. How many bowls will be required for 8 cups of soup.
- 7. The capacity of a kettle is 6 cups of tea. Already there are 3 cups of tea in kettle. How many cups of tea are needed to fill the kettle?
- 8. 1 bucket holds 8 mugs of water. Another bucket holds 12 mugs of water. How much water is there in 2 buckets?
- 9. A glass holds 10 spoons of juice. How much juice will make 3 glasses?
